2	$6 + 7 + 3 = 16$ $6 + 3 + 7 = 16$ $7 + 3 + 6 = 16$ Children may have found the last addition the easiest, as the first two digits summed to 10
3	No When we are adding numbers, it does not matter which order they are added.

5	19 Children may have added 8 and 2, and then added 9
