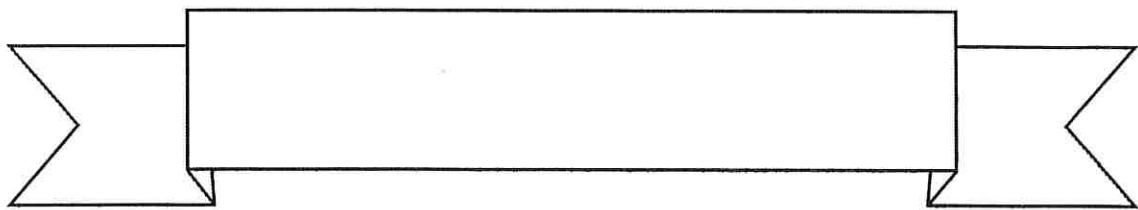


# OH THE PLACES YOU'LL GO

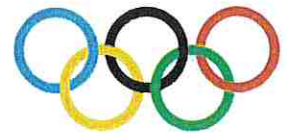




## Questions to ask when reading with my child

Reading a little with your child and asking one or two thought provoking questions can have a significant impact on their understanding of the book. Here are some suggestion questions:

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>VOCABULARY</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-What do the words..... tell us about the character?</li> <li>-Find a word that means .....</li> <li>-Which word tells us about character / the setting?</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>INFERENCE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-How do these words make you feel?</li> <li>-What was .....thinking when he / she said these words?</li> <li>-Find words which show that ..... e.g. (he / she is angry/confused etc)</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PREDICTION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-From the cover, what do you think this text is going to be about?</li> <li>-What will happen in the next chapter?</li> <li>-Is he/she kind / evil? Any evidence for this?</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>EXPLANATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Which section of text was most interesting?</li> <li>-Why is the text arranged this way?</li> <li>-Is the use of .....effective?</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RETRIEVAL</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-How did...?</li> <li>How often..?</li> <li>-What happened to...?</li> <li>-Give one example of...</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SUMMARISE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-What happened after....?</li> <li>-What was the first thing that happened in the story?</li> <li>-Can you summarise in a sentence the beginning / middle / end of the story?</li> </ul>
