The school is a single form entry for Nursery to Year 6, ages 3-11. Our nursery offers a 30 hour per week provision. Pupils at Beit Shvidler are instilled with a love for learning through an innovative Kodesh (Jewish studies) Curriculum and an excellent Chol (secular) education. The school is committed to helping all pupils fulfil their potential and become well-rounded individuals. It seeks to equip them with the necessary

academic and life skills so that they may participate confidently in society with pride in their Jewish identity. Beit Shvidler has a purpose built modern building with lots of space and fantastic facilities to give the children the best opportunity to succeed. Beit Shvidler was founded as a community school in conjunction with the Edgware Adath Yisroel Congregation. The school's Principal is also the Rav of the community, creating a close partnership between the school and shul.

Pupil learning is enhanced by a close partnership between teachers and families; parents take an active role in the education of their children. Parents are welcomed into the school for special occasions, assemblies, pupil presentations and performances and to join in the celebration of chagim. Parents hold places on the governing body as well as running the PTA which

holds events for the families of the school. We also have a Parent Council which delivers a formal system of parental representation in the school. We have strong relationships with many charities and partners who we regularly welcome into the school. We believe in creating a warm and friendly atmosphere in the school where everyone feels part of the Beit Shvidler family.
